<p>Insert the OpenLX Desktop CD in the CD-ROM, and boot the system with the “boot from cdrom” option. You will reach this screen :</p> 		<p>Press enter button. The next screen will be something like this :</p> 	
<p>Skip the CD Media testing in next screen and you will see this blue screen</p> 	<p>in this screen the installation will be shifting from text based to graphics base. The next screen will be this one :</p> 		<p>The graphics environment of the Linux installation process has started now</p>
<p>You will reach this welcome screen of the installation. Click the next button to move on further with the installation process</p> 		<p>Select the language in which you want to proceed with the installation process. In this manual we will use the English language. Click the next button to proceed further.</p>

	<p>Here, you select the keyboard layout. The default selection is “US. English” and this will be fine, having selected the English as the language earlier. Click the NEXT button to proceed further.</p> 		<p>Now, you will select your monitor, unless it has been detected automatically. Select the make & model of monitor. For unknown/un-available models, choose from Generic options. Click the NEXT button to proceed further.</p> 
<p>if you have not selected the appropriate monitor type, you will get a warning about that. Click on Proceed button to move ahead with the installation process</p> 		<p>in the next screen, the you will get an area to select the type of partition of your Hard Disk. we suggest , you go with the automatic partition. Manual Partition option requires an expertise which is not the scope of this manual. Click NEXT to move further.</p> 	
<p>In the next scree, select “Remove all partitions on this system” and click NEXT to move ahead. Also select “Review” option. Click on YES in next scree that is confirming your selection.</p>	<p>Next screen will show the partitions created. Click the NEXT button to proceed further. Next screen shows options of GRUB boot loader. Click the NEXT button to proceed further.</p>	<p>On NETWORK DEVICES screen, you can enter the IP addresses, if you are part of a LAN or leave default and Click the NEXT button to proceed further. Select “No Firewall” option and Click the NEXT button to proceed further. Click on “PROCEED” in next screen.</p>	<p>Additional languages are normally not required. Leave default and click on NEXT to move ahead. Leave Time-Zone to be Asia/Calcutta as default for India and click on NEXT. Enter the root password (& remember it). Click NEXT. On next screen, click NEXT and system will do Formatting & Installation.</p>
